# Doing more than the law requires

Matthew continues the Sermon on the Mount with a three part instruction by Jesus on the Way of Life in the kingdom of heaven. Today's reading is part one and deals with the Law. Part two deals with worship and religious practice and contains the Lord's Prayer. Part three deals with trusting God and deeds of loving service to our neighbor.

When Matthew speaks of "the Law and the prophets" he means the whole Scripture. When the Messiah brings the fullness of the kingdom none of scripture will be done away with. Instead it will be fulfilled. Matthew's Jesus does not overturn the Law of Moses, nor does he set his followers free from the Law. He requires his followers to go beyond the Law by doing more than the Law requires.

The Law condemned murder. Jesus condemns anger. The Law condemned adultery. Jesus condemns even lustful looks. As Jewish Chris-

If you work with children or vulnerable adults within Dunkeld Diocese you MUST be PVG (Protection of Vulnerable Groups) scheme registered for the specific role you have regardless of the membership you have for other businesses or organisations. Anyone working with children or vulnerable adults in the Church must be a member of the PVG scheme for the job they do in the Diocese of Dunkeld. If any volunteer in Ministry within a parish has not attended the new Level 1 Training during 2016, or more recently in Perth, they are reminded they should do so as soon as possible. Failure to attend Level 1 session can result in them being asked to step down from their respective ministries.
